The serial number of your iPad can be useful if you want to check your iPad or AppleCare warranty, but unlike some devices, it's not printed on a sticker stuck to the back of your device. The serial number can also be used to see if the iPad has been lost or stolen. Apple has outlined how to determine whether an activation device that is identified by its serial number is blocked on its support page. First, you'll need to log into your iPad settings. You can do this by clicking on the Settings app. Then scroll down the left menu and click on the General. In general settings, click on About. This is the first available option. The serial number is at the bottom of the information listed on your iPad. The Settings section contains several pieces of information that may be useful. There are many different types of iPad: iPad Air, iPad Air 2, iPad Mini, etc. You can also check the shared and affordable iPad storage from the About screen, as well as interesting facts such as the number of songs, videos, photos and apps you've uploaded to it. You can even give your iPad a new name by clicking on the name of your iPad device from The About settings. The serial number of your Mac is a unique identifier that distinguishes your Mac from everyone else. You must provide a serial number for your Mac when requesting warranty service. Flip over the MacBook and you'll see a serial number printed on the Mac itself, next to Apple Design text in California. On the Mac Mini, you'll find a serial number at the bottom. On the Mac Pro, you'll find it on the back. If you don't have access to a Mac, you can still find a serial number in different places. If you logged into your Mac with an Apple ID account, the serial number is tied to your Apple ID account online. Sign up for the Apple ID account website and sign up for the Apple ID account you're Mac. Click on the Mac name under under on the page that appears and you'll see the Mac serial number. Serial numbers are also sometimes, but not often referred to as serial serial It is important to distinguish serial numbers from other identifying codes or numbers. In short, the serial numbers are unique. UPC codes are common as well, but aren't really as unique as serial numbers. UPC codes differ from serial numbers because UPC codes are not unique to every single piece of hardware or software as serial numbers. You've probably seen serial numbers many times before. Almost every piece of computer has a serial number, including a monitor, keyboard, mouse, and sometimes even the entire computer system. The internal components of the computer, such as hard drives, optical discs and motherboards, also have serial numbers. Serial numbers are used by equipment manufacturers to track individual items, usually for quality control. For example, if a piece of equipment is recalled for any reason, customers are generally aware of which specific devices need maintenance by being provided with a number of serial numbers. Serial numbers are also used in non-technical environments, such as he-test instruments borrowed from a lab or workshop. It is easy to determine which devices should be returned or which ones were inappropriate because each of them can be identified by their unique serial number. Program serial numbers are typically used to ensure that the program is installed only once and only on the buyer's computer. Once the serial number is used and registered with the manufacturer, any future attempt to use the same serial number can raise a red flag, as no two serial numbers (from the same software) are similar. If you're planning to reinstall your purchased program, sometimes you'll need a serial number. See our guide on how to find a serial key if you need to reinstall the software.
